Fiscal Year 2022-23 Program Update #3- Family Fee Waivers

Child Development Associates (CDA) has been notified by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) that per Assembly Bill 210 family fees waivers have been extended for all families from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

What does this mean for families?

All families who are assessed a family fee **will not** have to pay family fees to their child care provider. *(Please note: Families may still be responsible for co-payments and should discuss this with their child care provider).*

What does this mean for child care providers?

Child care providers **should not** collect family fees from families from July 2022 through June 2023. CDA will reimburse child care providers **without deducting family fees** from their reimbursements through June 30, 2023.

When should families expect to pay family fees again?

The family fee waiver is set to expire June 30, 2023. Family fees will resume July 1, 2023.

Will CDA issue anew Notice of Action (NOA) and Certificate to show family fees are zero?

No, CDA is still required to assess family fees and report what is being waived to CDSS. If a family has a family fee, their NOA, Certificate and Attendance Records will continue to reflect the family fees.

How should attendance records be completed if there is a family fee assessed?

If a family has an assessed family fee reflected on any July 2022 through June 2023 Attendance Records, the provider can leave the field blank or write zero for the fee collected.
